



12 Grade 2015 vs 2019	-2pts	-3pts



Colorado Reading and Math Scores

	Average Reading Score Change	Average Math Score Change
4th Grade 2019 vs 2022	-2pts	-6pts
8th Grade 2019 vs 2022	-4pts	-10pts



Course-Taking Patterns


- Over ¼ of 12th graders took a dual-enrollment course in 2019
